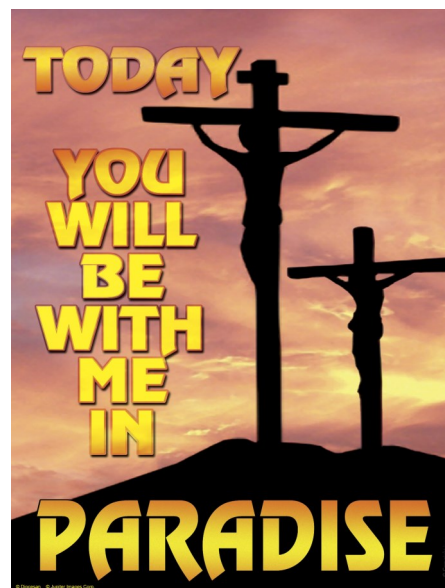

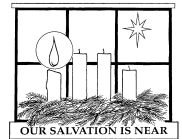
First place winners will receive prizes and have the opportunity to enter the next level of competition.
