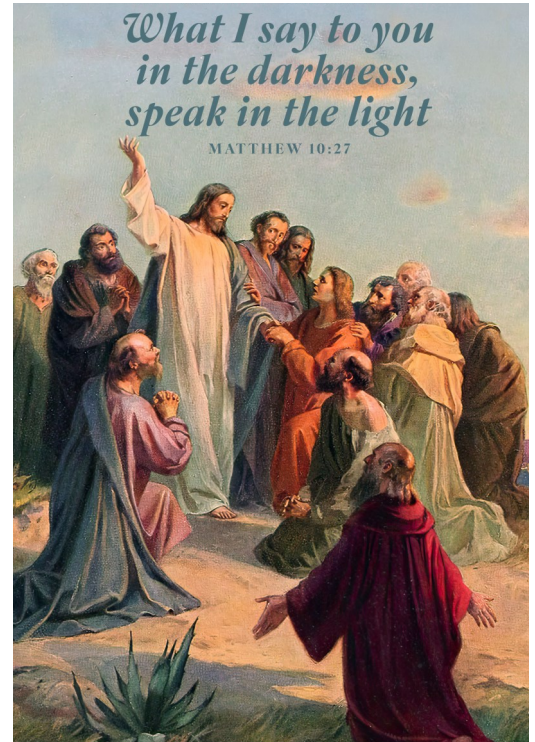

## Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

Have you heard about Catechesis of the Good Shepherd? Sometimes shortened to its acronym, (CGS), it is a distinct approach to catechesis, through which even the youngest children build deep, lifelong relationships with Christ and His Church. Originating in Rome in the 1950s, CGS uses a rich Montessori approach to engage children and youth in age-appropriate, hands-on materials based on Sacred Scripture and the Liturgy. Because it engages children so profoundly, it has become the best approach to catechesis in a growing number of dioceses, parishes, and schools around the US and the world. We are continuing to grow in this area at St. Mary. Some of our catechists are in south Florida right now, finishing intensive CGS training for level III! Please keep them in your prayers. *Sunday, June 28<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 pm*

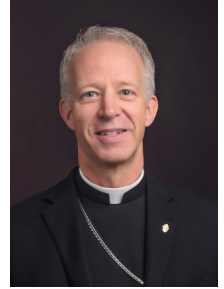
