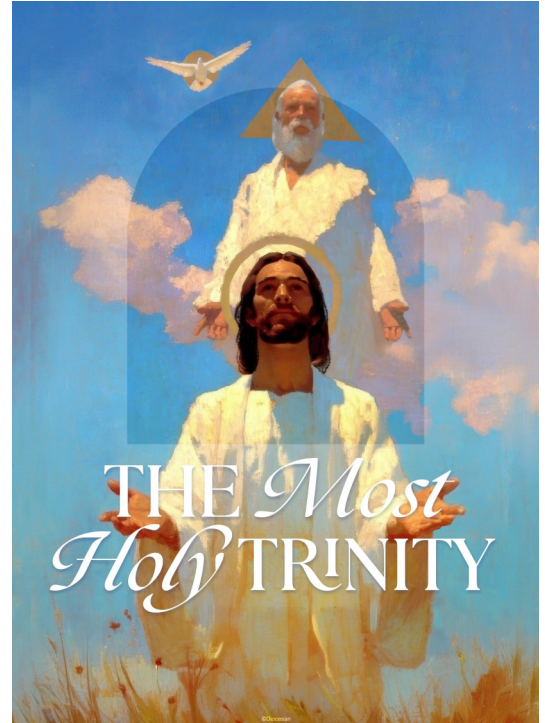

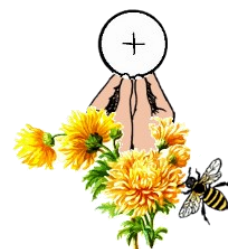


VBS Volunteers Meeting
