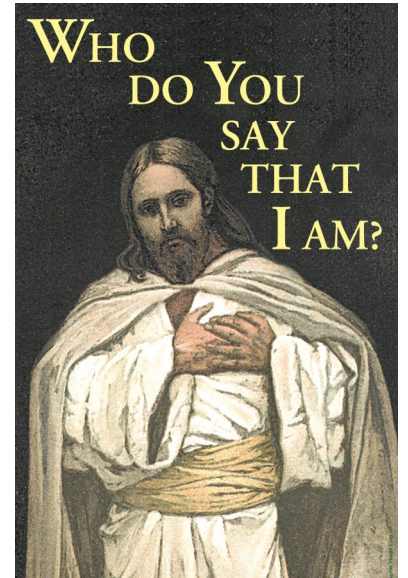

The theme, Growing as Disciples, Living as Apostles, will engage participants in a variety of relevant issues important for the Church today.

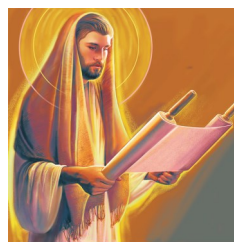

2020 Catholic Sharing Appeal

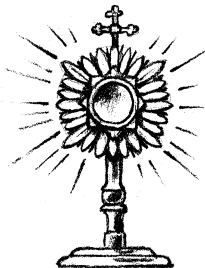

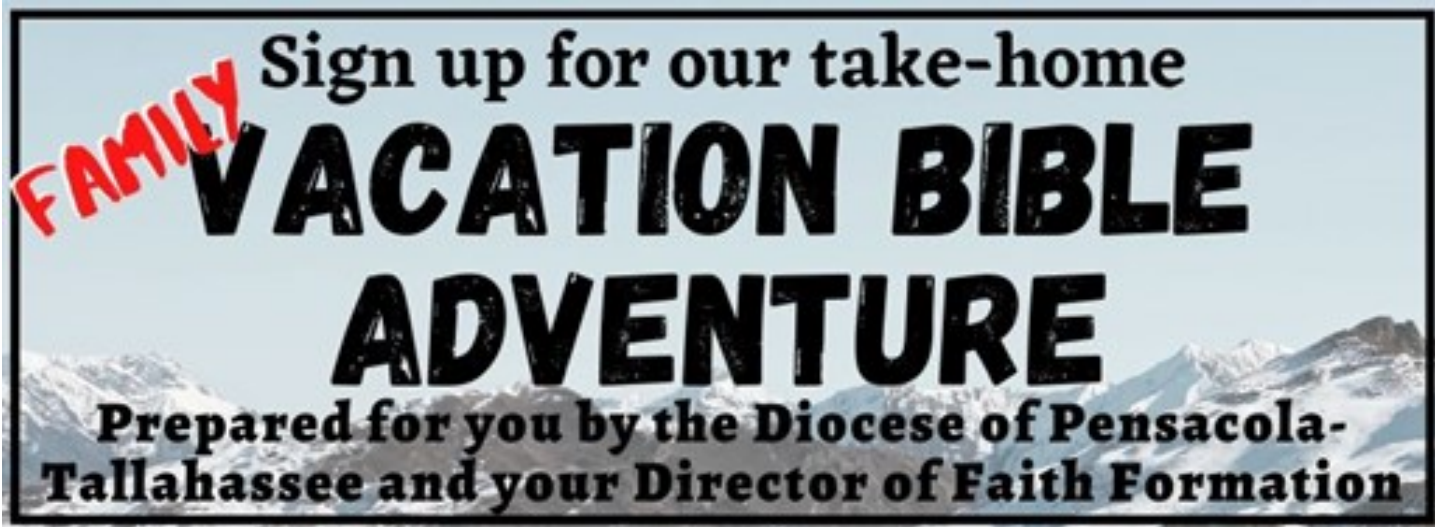
