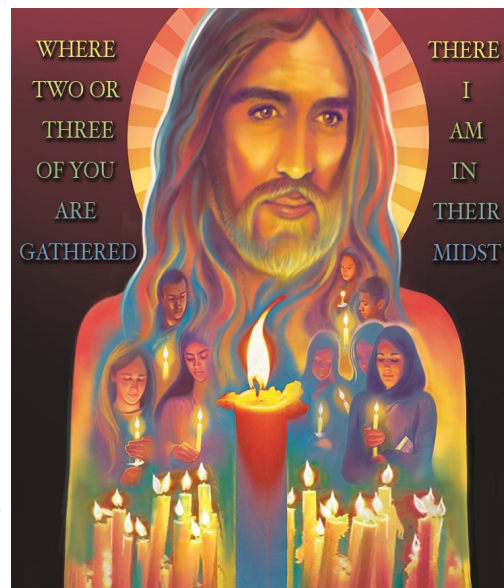

- Bishop Wack's dispensation remains in effect and we still plan to livestream Sunday Mass.

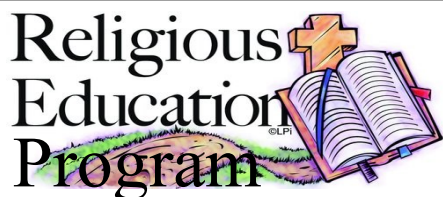

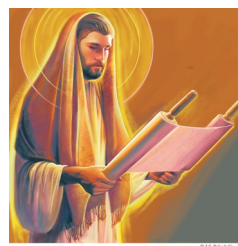

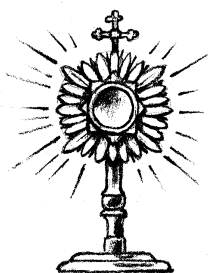
