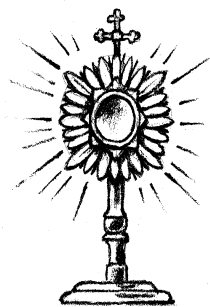
Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

Young children learn best by actively engaging their whole bodies and all their senses. The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is a distinct approach to catechesis, through which even the youngest children build deep, lifelong relationships with Christ and His Church. Originating in Rome in the 1950s, CGS uses a rich Montessori approach to engage children as young as 2 1/2 in age-appropriate, hands-on materials based on Sacred Scripture and the Liturgy. Because it engages children so profoundly, it has become the best approach to catechesis in a growing number of dioceses, parishes and schools around the US and the world.
