Parenting Conference

On Saturday, November 13th, our Diocese is hosting a conference at St. Paul Catholic Church in Pensacola called **Enkindling the Flame of Faith** to assist Catholic parents in their efforts to raise their children as Catholics with a real relationship with the Lord. It is a collaboration between the Diocesan Offices of Faith Formation, Youth Ministry and Marriage and Family Life. We are welcoming some excellent speakers from around the country to engage parents on the following core topics:

- The Centrality of Christ — how parents' personal relationship with Christ is the absolute essential element for effectively handing on the faith to their children
- The Kerygma for All Ages — how parents can proclaim the basic Gospel message to their kids from diapers all the way through high school
- The Spirituality of Parenting — how parents can understand their roles as the primary way God is inviting them into deeper relationship with Him

There will also be breakout sessions for parents to attend based on the age of their children. Finally there will be a closing panel with our speakers to answer questions.

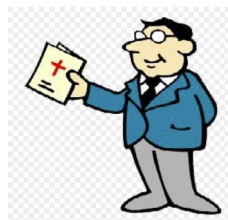

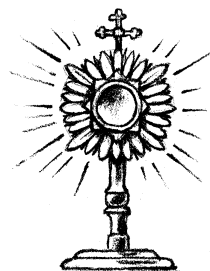
