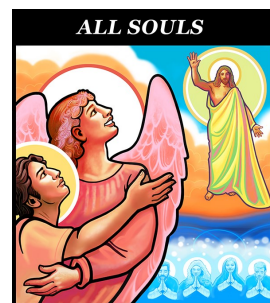

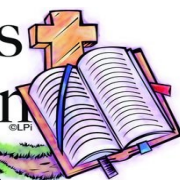

Come and have a Faith-filled fun family time. There will be something new to learn and ponder for everyone!

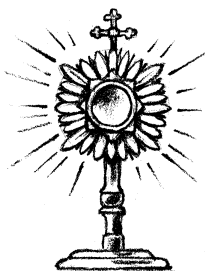

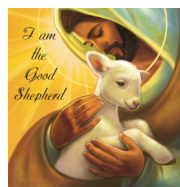
