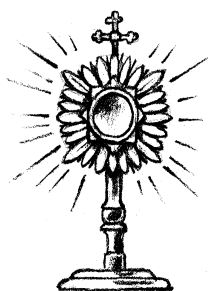

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

Young children learn best by actively engaging their whole bodies and all their senses. The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is a distinct approach to catechesis, through which even the youngest children build deep, lifelong relationships with Christ and His Church. Originating in Rome in the 1950s, CGS uses a rich Montessori approach to engage children as young as 2 1/2 in age-appropriate, hands-on materials based on Sacred Scripture and the Liturgy. Because it engages children so profoundly, it has become the best approach to catechesis in a growing number of dioceses, parishes and schools around the US and the world. Three of our catechists are taking intensive CGS training this summer! Please pray for them, that this will be a particularly fruitful time of growth and renewal in the service of the children of our parish.
