Majella House Inc. is a non-profit maternity home for homeless pregnant mothers and their children based on the tremendous need for a home along the Emerald Coast.

- Currently, there is only one maternity home in a five-county area meeting this need.
- Over 50% of single-mom households in our area live in poverty
- 80% of abortions are economically motivated.
- 70% of single moms do not have a GED or high school diploma.

Majella House operates under the belief that if we are going to ask moms to choose life, we need to be able to house them when they are homeless, especially homeless with multiple children

HOW WE SERVE

HOMELESS PREGNANT MOTHERS AND THEIR CHILDREN

We provide housing and related support to homeless, pregnant mothers and their children. We help with pregnancy and parenting needs before, during and after birth.

EDUCATION / JOB READINESS

We provide educational and job readiness assistance to enable our mothers to sufficiently provide for their families and live independently.

COMMUNITY RESOURCES

We connect homeless, pregnant mothers with community resources for drug, alcohol and mental health counseling, addressing their needs. We provide trauma and post-abortion healing as 50% of single moms have already lost a child to abortion.

CHILDCARE FOR WORKING MOMS

We provide in-home childcare for resident-moms who are working and who need childcare for medical appointments.

SPIRITUAL ASSISTANCE

Daily prayer and spiritual direction opportunities are available in our home to connect mothers to the love of our Heavenly Father.

NAPRO TECHNOLOGY

Classes are offered in Natural Procreative Technology. NaPro Technology is a new women's health science that monitors and maintains a woman's reproductive health.
